FIELD BOARD ADDENDUM

Amenities included in FIELD board:

- Fully enclosed paddock with access to a run in shed
- 24/7 access to water through spring and well fed drinkers
 - buckets will be provided and checked often in cases of drinker outage
- Vet/farrier holds for routine care up to 1 hour
 - Must be scheduled with LIBERTY HALL providers during routine stable wide services or arranged with management prior at least 1 week in advance.
 - OWNER must arrange and make payment directly with vet/farrier
 - Holds over an hour will be assessed a fee of \$15 per hour
- Welfare checks 2x daily
- Round bales provided when paddock grass is not sufficient
- Once a day feeding – morning or evening
 - Your choice of grain from one of our quality offerings (other brands may be available at additional costs)
- supplements with feeding (owner bagged and provided)
- Blanket change, up to once a day based on weather forecast
 - blankets provided by OWNER
- Vet/farrier holds for routine care up to 1 hour
 - Must be scheduled with LIBERTY HALL providers during routine stable wide services or arranged with management prior at least 1 week in advance.
 - OWNER must arrange and make payment directly with vet/farrier
 - Holds over an hour will be assessed a fee of \$15 per hour
- Access to LIBERTY HALL's facilities during **free and open times**; cross-country trails, indoor arena, outdoor arena, foot paths and round pens.
- Assigned space in tack room in one of the barns, wash room stall, and other facilities within barns as are open and available for general boarders use.

Amenities not included in Board:

- Extra care for wounds/injuries (standard care at \$10/day or discuss with management for atypical care)
- Vet/farrier holds outside of business hours, by outside providers, or not arranged prior to visit.
- Administration of medicines, powders or atypical supplements (Bute, banamine, vet wrap, magic cushion, ichthammol, etc.)

Additional Notes:

OWNER, rider or handler is responsible for returning horse to the appropriate paddock. Paddocks will be rotated and may change, at management's sole discretion, for the health and safety of your horse(s) and others. Rotations and Changes to Paddocks will be noticed by posting in Barns and/or directly to OWNER.
